In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (6) of section 39 read with section 168 of the Certarl Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (12 of 2017), the Commissioner, on the recommendations of the Council, hereby extends the time limit for furnishing the return in FORM GSTR-3B electronically, through the common portal, by the registered persons, as specified under-

(i) sub-section (1) of section 39, for the month of December 2024, till twenty-second day of January, 2025:

(ii) proviso to sub-section (1) of section 39 for the quarter of October,2024 to December,2024, for the class of registered persons mensioned in column (2) of the Table given below, till the date mensioned in the corresponding entry in column (3) of the said Table, namely: -

G.S.R....[El.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the first proviso to sub-section (1) of section 37 read with section 168 of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 (12 of 2017), the Commissioner, on the recommendations of the Council, hereby makes the following further amendment in the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue), No. 83/2030—Central Tax, dated to 10° November, 2020, published in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section 3, Sub-section (i) vide number G.S.R. 699(E), dated the 10° November, 2020, numely:—

In the said notification, after the fifth proviso, the following proviso shall be inserted, namely:-

"Provided also that the time limit for furnishing the details of ourward supplies in FORM OSTR-1 of the said rules for the registered persons required to furnish return under sub-section (1) of section 39 of the said Act for the tax period December, 2004, shall be extended till the thirteenth day of January, 2025 and for the registered persons who are required to furnish return under proviso of the said sub-section, for the tax period October to December, 2024, shall be extended till the fifteenth day of January, 2025."
